



SAFETY PROCEDURES



Setting up schoolwide and classroom safety procedures ensures the safety for all students and staff within the building

ROOM CLEAR PROCEDURE

A room clear may be necessary to remove other students when a student is engaging in problem behaviors. It is easier and safer to remove the other students from room.

- Is there a room clear procedure for the classroom?
- Have all classroom staff been trained on room clear procedures?
- Have the classroom students been explicitly taught the procedure and had opportunities to practice the skill outside of crisis event?

STUDENT CRISIS PLANS

- Do individual students display behavior that is a danger to self or others?
- Do they have plans developed to address these behaviors?
- Are staff aware of individual student crisis plans?
- Have staff been trained in implementing the plan?

STAFF TRAINING FOR CRISIS EVENTS

- Have building and classroom staff been trained in the following?
 - De-escalation strategies
 - Safe physical management procedures
 - Documentation of event
 - Debriefing the event

SCHOOLWIDE SAFETY PROCEDURES

- Is there an emergency procedure for crisis events outside the classroom?
- Does the building have a crisis team trained in safe physical management procedures?
- Does the building have a communication system established to request support with crisis events?
